## Propositions

### State of New York

#### Proposal One, an amendment

##### Removal of Small City School Districts From Special Constitutional Debt Limitation

The proposed amendment to Article 8, section 4 of the Constitution removes the special constitutional debt limitation now placed on small city school districts, so they will be treated the same as all other school districts. Shall the proposed amendment be approved?

#### Proposal Two, an amendment

##### Extending Sewage Project Debt Exclusion From Debt Limit

The proposed amendment to Article 8, section 5 of the Constitution extends for ten years the authority of counties, cities, towns, and villages to remove from their constitutional debt limits debt for the construction of sewage facilities. Shall the proposed amendment be approved?

#### Proposal Three, County Proposition One

"Shall there be approved in the County of Cortland, New York, a Local Law entitled "Redistricting the County of Cortland", as enacted by the Legislature of the County of Cortland, New York on April 27, 2023, reducing the number of legislative districts within Cortland County from seventeen (17) to fifteen (15)?"

#### Proposal Four, Town Proposition One

Would the residents of Cincinnatus be in favor of changing the elected term of the Town Supervisor from 2 years to 4 years?

#### Proposal Five, Town Proposition Two

Would the residents of Cincinnatus be in favor of changing the elected term of the Town Clerk/Collector from 2 years to 4 years?

#### Proposal Four, Town Proposition One

A resolution was adopted on August 7, 2023 by the Town Board of the Town of Cortlandville, pursuant to Section 60-a of Town Law, to eliminate the position of second Cortlandville Town Justice in the Town of Cortlandville, Cortland County, New York, effective the first day of January following the election held on November 7, 2023. Should this resolution be approved?

#### Proposal Four, Town Proposition One

Proposed Local Law #6 of the year 2023 entitled Games of Chance and the Conduct Thereof by Authorized Organizations will allow charitable organizations to operate raffles and other games of chance in the Town of Virgil to raise funds for charitable purposes. Shall the proposed local law be approved?
