ADOPTING LOCAL LAW NO. 1 FOR THE YEAR 1980

WHEREAS, Local Law No. 1 for the year 1980 providing for an increase in the salary of the Director of Planning, Commissioner of Social Services, Director of Personnel, Public Health Administrator, Director Real Property Tax Services, Election Commissioners (2), Chairperson Civil Service Commission, Commissioners Civil Service Commission (2), Director Veterans Service Agency, and the Superintendent of Highways, was introduced by Mr. Palm, a member of this Legislature, at a meeting of this Legislature held on December 19, 1979 and

WHEREAS, said Local Law has been in its final form upon the desks of the members at least seven days exclusive of Sunday, prior to this date, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing thereon has been held before this Legislature, after publication, of notice thereof as required by law, now therefor be it
