

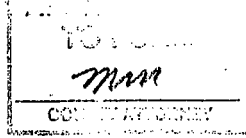
ADOPTING LOCAL LAW NUMBER 5  
FOR THE YEAR 1985

WHEREAS, Local Law No. 5 for the year 1985, providing for a retirement incentive program for the eligible employees of the County of Cortland, State of New York, as authorized by Chapter 665, Laws of 1984 was introduced by Mrs. Contento, a member of this Legislature, at a meeting of this Legislature held on September 25, 1985, and

WHEREAS, said Local Law has been in its final form on the desks of the members at least seven (7) days prior to this date, and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing thereon has been held before this Legislature after publication of notice thereof as required by Law, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that Local Law Number 5 for the year 1985 is hereby passed and enacted in the following form, subject to a permissive referendum.

A RETIREMENT INCENTIVE PROGRAM FOR THE ELIGIBLE EMPLOYEES OF  
THE COUNTY OF CORTLAND, STATE OF NEW YORK, AS AUTHORIZED BY  
CHAPTER 665, LAWS OF 1984

BE IT ENACTED, BY THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF CORTLAND, STATE OF NEW YORK, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The County Legislature of the County of Cortland hereby finds and declares that it is in the best interest of the County to provide its eligible employees with a retirement incentive program authorized by Chapter 665, Laws of 1984, and hereby elects to provide said retirement program to those of its employees who are eligible to take part in said program.

Section 2. The commencement date of the retirement incentive program shall be June 1, 1986. The open period during which eligible employees may retire and receive the additional retirement service credits, shall be (90) days in length.

Section 3. This Local Law shall be effective immediately, subject only to the filing of this Law with the Secretary of State as prescribed by Law.
