

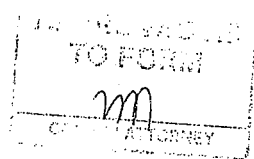
DIRECT PUBLIC HEARING FOR PROPOSED

A local law TO ESTABLISH A SOLID WASTE DEPARTMENT FOR THE COUNTY OF CORTLAND

Be it enacted by the CORTLAND COUNTY LEGISLATURE of the

- SECTION 1. There is hereby created a Solid Waste Department as an Agency of the County to operate Solid Waste Disposal facilities and otherwise facilitate the disposal of solid waste including the operation of County owned or operated Solid Waste Disposal facilities.
- SECTION 2. The head of said Department shall be the Director of Solid Waste Management who shall be appointed by the Cortland County Legislature to serve a four (4) year term. The compensation for the Director of Solid Waste Management shall be fixed by resolution of the Cortland County Legislature at the time of appointment.
- SECTION 3. The County Legislature may create and establish such other and further positions or memberships within the Solid Waste Department as it deems necessary for the operation of the Department and the County Solid Waste Disposal facilities.
- SECTION 4. The existing standing Committee known as the Solid Waste Disposal Committee shall be the committee of the Solid Waste Department.
- SECTION 5. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
