

LOCAL LAW NO. 1 YEAR 1954

County of Cortland, New York

A LOCAL LAW amending Section 151, Subdivision 1 of the County Law of the State of New York, to provide for organizing the Board of Supervisors and selecting a chairman on or before the 8th day of January in each even-numbered year.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Cortland, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Section 151 of the County Law of the State of New York, and Chapter 11 of the Laws of 1950, Subdivision 1 thereof in so far as the same applies to the County of Cortland is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 151. Organization of Board.

1. The members of the board of supervisors shall organize the board and select a chairman at the call of the clerk of the board on or before the eighth day of January in each even-numbered year. The board shall fix the date, time and place of meeting by local law duly adopted. The board may provide by local law that the members of the board shall meet to organize and select a chairman on or before the eighth day of January in each even-numbered year. The clerk of the board of supervisors shall serve upon each member a notice stating the date, time and place of each meeting to organize the board and that a chairman will then be selected. The notice shall be in writing and shall be served by mail addressed to each member at his last known post-office address at least forty-eight hours before the date of the meeting.

Section 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that there has been duly presented to and introduced before the Board of Supervisors of the County of Cortland, New York, on July 7, 1954, Local Law No. 1 of the Year 1954, entitled as "A LOCAL LAW amending Section 151, Subdivision 1 of the County Law of the State of New York, to provide for organizing the Board of Supervisors and selecting a chairman on or before the 8th day of January in each even-numbered year."

Said proposed Local Law provides:

"BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Cortland, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Section 151 of the County Law of the State of New York, Chapter 11 of the Laws of 1950, Subdivision 1 thereof in so far as the same applies to the County of Cortland is hereby amended to read as follows:

The clerk of the board of supervisors shall serve upon each member a notice stating the date, time and place of each meeting to organize the board and that a chairman will then be selected. The notice shall be in writing and shall be served by mail addressed to each member at his last known post-office address at least forty-eight hours before the date of the meeting.

This local law shall take effect immediately."

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the said Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing on the aforesaid proposed Local Law at the Supervisors' Chambers, County Building, Cortland, New York, at ten o'clock in the forenoon on September 1, 1954, at which time all persons interested will be heard.
