

Adopt Local Law No. 2 For The Year 2006

A Local Law Superseding County Law 214
To Authorize Abstract Publication

Be it enacted by the County Legislature of the County of Cortland as follows:

SECTION 1: PURPOSE: County Law 214 required the Clerk of the Legislature to publish a true copy of the full text of each local law in the official newspaper(s). This Local Law is intended to supersede that requirement by authorizing publication of an abstract, rather than the full text, of each local law.

SECTION 2: Except as otherwise provided by law, the Clerk of the Legislature, shall cause an abstract of each local law to be published in the county's official newspaper(s) at least once a week for two successive weeks, the first publication of which shall be had within ten days after each local law has been effective; provided, however, that any local law which is subject to a permissive referendum shall be published in such official newspaper at least once a week for two successive weeks, the first publication of which shall be had within ten days after such local law is adopted. Such abstract shall concisely state the purpose and effect of each local law.


SECTION 3: The Clerk of the Legislature shall make a true copy of each local law available for public inspection and/or copying during the office's regular business hours for one hundred and fifty days after the effective date of such local law.

SECTION 4: The Local Law shall become effective as provided in Municipal Home Rule Law Section 27.
