SECTION 1: APPLICATION OF LAW

The provisions of this Law shall apply to motor vehicles and the owner and operators thereof, operated, located or situated upon real property owned, rented, leased or otherwise controlled by the County of Cortland and the Law shall apply except where it is necessary to stop a vehicle to avoid conflict with other traffic or in compliance with the directions of a police officer or official traffic control device.

SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS

All words appearing in this Law which are defined in the New York State Vehicle and Traffic Law shall have the same definition as is set forth in that Law as if the same had been set forth in this Law.

SECTION 3: ALL NIGHT PARKING

The parking of vehicles other than County owned or leased vehicles or vehicles of County employees then on duty is hereby prohibited on all property owned by the County of Cortland between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

SECTION 4: COMPLETE PROHIBITION OF OPERATION AND PARKING

The operation and parking of vehicles except County vehicles performing maintenance work, is hereby prohibited on all property owned by the County of Cortland, except in areas designed as parking spaces, driveways, roadways, picnic and park areas not otherwise restricted as to driving and parking.

SECTION 5: PARTICULAR LIMITATION OF PARKING COUNTY OWNED MUNICIPAL LOTS

The parking of vehicles in the municipal parking lots of the County of Cortland located adjacent to the County Office Building and the County Courthouse and Jail shall be limited to County owned vehicles and vehicles of persons then visiting a Cortland County Municipal Office or the Jail, and vehicles of employees of the County of Cortland while said employee is working at a County Office, and such other vehicles as may from time to time be authorized to parking in said lots. Said authorization shall be given by the Cortland County Safety Officer or his designees.

SECTION 6: Persons authorized to park in County parking lots shall adhere to all parking and driving regulations posted in said lot pursuant to this Local Law. The Building and Grounds Committee shall be authorized to cause signs to be posed indicating restricted areas

SECTION 7: The Superintendent of Buildings and Grounds shall cause to be prepared schematic drawing or layout of the Cortland County parking lots and said drawing shall contain indicated parking spaces, driving lanes, loading zones, handicapped areas, fire lanes and such other designated area as may seem proper for the safe operation and parking of vehicles. This drawing shall be submitted to the Building and Grounds Committee of the Cortland County Legislature for its approval and after modification, if any, and approval, the same shall regulate traffic and parking in the County parking areas. The schematic drawing and any modifications shall be filed with the Cortland County Safety Officer.

SECTION 8: All restricted areas shall be properly marked so as to advise the public as to the restrictions.

SECTION 9: City of Cortland Police Officers or County Sheriff Deputies or other persons authorized by the City or county to issue parking tickets are hereby authorized to institute prosecutions for violation of any provision of this Local Law by the issuance of appearance tickets.

SECTION 10: A person found to have violated any provision of this Local Law shall be guilty of an offense and punished by a fine of eight dollars, (\$8.00), for each offense; except violations in handicapped zones shall be punished by a fine of twenty five, (\$25.00) dollars.
