Local Law No. 4 of the Year 2000

**A LOCAL LAW AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION BY
CORTLAND COUNTY LEGISLATURE TO EMPIRE STATE DEVELOPMENT FOR
DESIGNATION OF AN AREA WITHIN CORTLAND COUNTY AS AN EMPIRE
ZONE**

Be it Enacted by the Legislature of the County of Cortland as follows:

PREAMBLE

It is the public policy of the State of New York to offer incentives through the creation of Empire Zones that will promote the development of new business and the expansion of existing business within economically impoverished areas and to do so without inducing the relocation of business investment from other areas of the State. It is also the public policy of New York State to achieve their goals through the mutual cooperation of all levels of State and local governments and the business community. It is the intent of this Local Law to authorize Cortland County to submit an application for Empire Zone Designation pursuant to General Municipal Law Section 960.

SECTION I

The Chairman of the Cortland County Legislature is hereby authorized to submit an application to Empire State Development for designation of an area within Cortland County, as described in Section II hereof, as an Empire Zone.

SECTION II

The boundaries of such Empire Zone are described as follows:

EMPIRE ZONE BOUNDARY DELINEATION

The Empire Zone encompasses a total of 928± acres, in eleven (11) non-contiguous areas within Cortland County.
