Agenda Item: Community Updates:

Tiffanie Parker (Department of Social Services) – Homeless population – work with local providers; i.e., law enforcement, CCOCC, COTI team, DSS, etc. – doing homeless outreach one time per year, before weather changes – two teams, one with Sheriff’s Department and one with City PD – existing, known, encampments – bringing food, Narcan, and information to aid / Amanda Howlett (DSS) – Warming Center has not opened – weather has not made it necessary – the criteria, activates “Code Blue” offering warming options; i.e., authorization for staying inside the County Office Building during the day

Cristin Marshall (SPOA Coordinator, County Department of Mental Health) – Training for Post Trauma Response Team – November 17 for new volunteers

Amanda (Mandy) Stout (Family & Children’s Counseling Services) – met with REACH Medical – finding ways to work together – ensure services do not overlap / process at Jail by F&CCS therapist going well – working to connect people with services as they leave the Jail i.e., connecting with treatment

Captain Nicholas Lynch (Cortland County Jail) – MAT (medically assisted treatment) running well – 14 participants, currently / discussed the increase of overdose deaths as relates to bail reform – lost opportunity to intervene and get help while individual is incarcerated

Jackie Leaf (Seven Valley Health Coalition) – program up and running (SVHC Food Rescue) – fully operational – not open to public – more food is donated (produce) as word is spread – volunteers come to sort food and deliver to various food pantries

ReBecca Smith (Health Department) – new laws enacted this week – all County grounds are tobacco and cannabis free – City passed law preventing use of tobacco and cannabis on Main Street from Clinton Ave to the High School (smoking and vaping)

Andrea Morgia (Liberty Resources – Mobile Crisis) - Very busy – talking to teams about the type of response when drugs or alcohol are involved

Sara Watrous (CACTC, HEALing Communities) – strategies – join work group – January implementation starts
