

RESOLUTION NO. 73-22

Local Law 4 of 2022 - a Local Law Amending Local Law 2 of 1972 - a Local Law Reapportioning the County of Cortland

WHEREAS, the three month timeline for the Redistricting Commission as established by Local Law 2 of 1972 is insufficient given the challenges posed by numerous factors in 2022, AND

WHEREAS, those factors include a significant delay in the release of the 2020 Census figures by the Federal government, and the adverse impacts posed by the COVID pandemic, AND

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the members of the Redistricting Commission to allow for sufficient time to consider the impact public input and proposed changes in districts and/or district lines may have on the Redistricting Commission's ability to ensure proposed reconfigured maps comply with all the regulations and technical criteria set forth in, and mandated by, newly-released state law, AND

WHEREAS, the deadline of three months to review and submit a proposal sufficient to address the redistricting needs of Cortland County is insufficient given the issues articulated above;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the Legislature of the County of Cortland, as follows:

Local Law 2 of 1972 is hereby amended as follows:

Article 1:

That Section 206 Paragraph 2, Sentence 2 of Local Law 2 of 1972 is hereby amended by replacing the existing sentence 2 with the following:

The commission shall study the population data and within four (4) months after appointment make recommendations, if necessary, in the form of a proposed local law as to changes in the boundaries of county legislative districts.


Article 2:

Effective Date: This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing in the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with the requirements of Municipal Home Rule Law.
