

ADOPTING LOCAL LAW NO. 3 FOR THE YEAR 1978

WHEREAS, Local Law No. 3 for the year 1978, amending Local Law No. 4 for the year 1971, providing for a decrease in the number of members of the Cortland County Traffic Safety Board from 20 to 12, was introduced by Mr. Leombruno, a member of this Legislature, at a meeting of this Legislature held on November 13, 1978, and

WHEREAS, said Local Law has been in its final form upon the desks of the members at least seven days, exclusive of Sunday prior to this date, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing thereon has been held before this Legislature, after publication of notice thereof as required by law, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that Local Law No. 3 for the year 1978 is hereby passed and enacted in the following form:

LOCAL LAW NO. 3 FOR THE YEAR 1978

"A LOCAL LAW AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 4 FOR THE YEAR 1978, ESTABLISHING A TRAFFIC SAFETY BOARD."

BE IT ENACTED, by the Cortland County Legislature as follows:

Section 1: Section 2 of Local Law No. 4 for the year 1971 be and hereby is amended to read:

"Section 2: Pursuant to Section Sixteen Hundred Seventy-three of such Law, the Board shall be composed of 12 members appointed by the County Legislature, each and all members of said Traffic Safety Board to have the qualifications set forth in such Section Sixteen Hundred Seventy-three."

Section 2: This Local Law shall become effective upon filing with the Secretary of State in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
