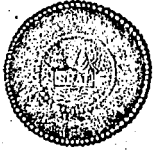

ADOPTING LOCAL LAW NO. 4 FOR THE YEAR 1975

WHEREAS, Local Law No. 4 for the year 1975 providing for an increase in the salary of the Superintendent of Highways and the County Attorney was introduced by Mr. Colasurdo, a member of this Legislature at the meeting of this Legislature held on May 28, 1975, and

WHEREAS, said Local Law has been in its final form upon the desks of the members at least seven calender days exclusive of Sunday prior to this date, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing thereon has been held before this Legislature after publication of a notice thereof as required by law, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, that Local Law No. 4 for the year 1975, which Local Law increases the salary of the Superintendent of Highways and the County Attorney be passed and enacted in the following form, subject to a permissive referendum;

BE IT ENACTED, by the County Legislature of the County of Cortland as follows:

SECTION 1. Commencing August first, nineteen hundred seventy-five, the annual salary of the Cortland County Superintendent of Highways shall be set at \$21,000.00.

SECTION 2. Commencing August first, nineteen hundred seventy-five, the annual salary of the Cortland County Attorney shall be \$12,045.00.

SECTION 3. This Local Law shall take effect upon filing with the Secretary of State in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law.




