FOR THE YEAR 1985  
AMENDING LOCAL LAW NO. 1  
FOR THE YEAR 1971

Section 1 of local Law No. 1 for the year 1971, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Pursuant to the provisions of section eight hundred six of the General Municipal Law, the (Board of Supervisors) County Legislature of the County of Cortland recognizes that there are rules of ethical conduct for public officers and employees which must be observed if a high degree of moral conduct is to be obtained and if public confidence is to be maintained in our unit of local government. It is the purpose of this local law to promulgate these rules of ethical conduct for the officers and employees of the County of Cortland. These rules shall serve as a guide for official conduct of the officers and employees of the County of Cortland.

The rules of ethical conduct of this local law as adopted, shall not conflict with, but shall be in addition to any prohibition of article eighteen of the General Municipal Law or any other general or special law relating to ethical conduct and interest in contracts of municipal officers and employees.

Section 3 (e) of Local Law No. 1 for the year 1971, is hereby amended to read as follows:

DISCLOSURE OF INTEREST IN LEGISLATION. To the extent that he knows thereof, a member of the (Board of Supervisors) County Legislature and any officer or employee of the County of Cortland, whether paid or unpaid, who participated in the discussion or gives official opinion to the (Board of Supervisors) County Legislature on any legislation before the (Board of Supervisors) County Legislature shall publicly disclose on the official record the nature and extent of any direct or indirect financial or other private interest he has in such legislation.

Section 5 of Local Law No. 1 for the year 1971, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(The Clerk of the County Legislature) The Department of Personnel/Civil Service shall cause a copy of this code of ethics to be distributed to every officer and employee of the County of Cortland within 30 days after the effective date of this local law. Each officer and employee elected or appointed thereafter, shall be furnished a copy before entering upon the duties of his office or employment.

This code must be posted in a conspicuous place in the immediate vicinity of the place of work so as to comply to an essential element of due process.
