WHEREAS, a proposed Local Law for the year 1985 amending Local Law No. 1 for the year 1982 was introduced by Mrs. Contento, a member of the Legislature, at a meeting of this Legislature held on January 9, 1985, and

WHEREAS, said Local Law has been in its final form on the desks of the members at least 7 days prior to this date, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing thereon has been held before this Legislature after publication of notice thereof as required by law, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that a Local Law amending Local Law No. 1 for the year 1982 is hereby passed and enacted in the following form, subject to a permissive referendum:

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the County of Cortland, New York, as follows:

Section 1. Article three, paragraph number 5 of Local Law Number One for the year 1982 is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

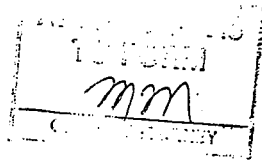
District #3 (formerly #14)

Beginning at a point where Dry Creek intersects with the westerly boundary of the City of Cortland; thence northeasterly along the center line of Dry Creek to the point where Madison Street intersects said center line; thence easterly along the center line of Madison Street to the center line of Floral Avenue; thence southerly along the center line of Floral Avenue to the center line of Groton Avenue; thence easterly along the center line of Groton Avenue to the center line of Stevenson Street; thence southerly along the center line of Stevenson Street to the center line of Clayton Avenue; thence easterly along the center line of Clayton Avenue to the center line of Main Street; thence southerly along the center line of Main Street to the center line of Tompkins Street; thence southwesterly along the center line of Tompkins Street to the center line of Sands Street; thence northerly along the center line of Sands Street to the center line of Water Street; thence northerly along the center line of an extension of Water Street to the center line of Prospect Terrace; thence westerly along Prospect Terrace and an extension thereof to the westerly boundary of the City of Cortland, thence northerly to the place of beginning.

Section 2. Article three, paragraph number 6 of Local Law Number One for the year 1982 is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

ALL THAT PORTION OF THE CITY OF CORTLAND LYING WITHIN THE FOLLOWING BOUNDARIES: Beginning at a point where the center line of Delaware Street intersects with the southerly boundary of the City of Cortland; thence northerly along the center line of Delaware Street to the center line of Squires Street; thence easterly along the center line of Squires Street to the center line of Duane Street; thence northerly along the center line of Duane Street to the center line of Tompkins Street; thence southwesterly along the center line of Tompkins Street to the center line of Sands Street; thence northwesterly along the center line of Sands Street to the center line of Water Street; thence northerly along the center line of Water Street and an extension thereof to the center line of Prospect Terrace; thence westerly along the center line of Prospect Terrace and an extension thereof to the westerly boundary of the City of Cortland; thence southerly to the southwest corner of the City of Cortland; thence easterly along the southerly boundary line of the City of Cortland to the place of beginning.

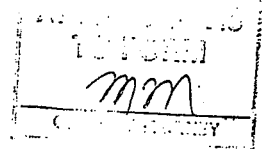
