ADOPTING LOCAL LAW NO. 2 FOR THE YEAR 1988

TO REVISE APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION FUND

WHEREAS, the County of Cortland pursuant to the Workers' Compensation Law has established a self-insurance plan, and

WHEREAS, Proposed Local Law No. 2 for the year 1988 provides for distribution of the cost of administering the Workers' Compensation Fund in a more fair and equitable manner, and which is more in line with the procedures followed by investor owned insurance companies. The proposal to distribute costs is New York State Law as introduced by Mrs. Contento, a member of this Legislature at the Legislative meeting held on June 22, 1988, and

WHEREAS, said Local Law has been in its final form upon the desks of the members at least seven (7) calendar days exclusive of Sunday prior to this date, and

WHEREAS, a Public Hearing thereon has been held before this Legislature after publication of notice thereof required by law, NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that Local Law No. 2 for the year 1988 be passed and enacted in the following form:

A LOCAL LAW TO REVISE APPORTIONMENT OF COSTS OF THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CORTLAND COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF THE COUNTY OF CORTLAND, NEW YORK AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The apportionment of costs of administering the County Self Insurance Fund shall be shared by the participants in the following manner:

YEAR	APPORTIONMENT
1986	50% Full Value Assessment 50% Experience
1987 and Thereafter	40% Full Value Assessment 60% Experience

SECTION 2. When calculating the full value assessment of the towns of Cortlandville, Homer and Marathon, the village assessment within these towns shall be excluded.

SECTION 3. When calculating the experience rating for each participant, a twenty thousand dollar cost cap shall be imposed on each incident per year. This is done for purposes of limiting the exposure to a participant for any extraordinary costs that may arise in a given year, in any single incident.

SECTION 4. A separate line item in the operating budget shall be created commencing in the 1986 Workers' Compensation Fund Operating Budget for purposes of funding the reserve account until such time as the reserve fund totals \$500,000., the maximum allowed by Local Law.
